Conditionally that if he should not make his personal appearance before the Justices of this Court to be hold for the County and at any time During the same now sitting to Answer unto what should be objected against him on his Lordships behalf and if that in y^e mean time he should not be of good behaviour And the s^r Daniel having appeared according to his Recognizance as aforesaid is Discharged

also Philip Brooks & George Gleasons both of Kent County Planters at this Court as y^e Did Acknowledge themselves Indebted unto y^e Right Hon^{ble} the Lord Prop^{ty} of this Province of Maryland in the Sum of twenty pounds Sterl money of Great Britain to be Levied of their several Goods & Chattels Lands &c. for the use of y^e s^r Lord Prop^{ty} his heirs &c. Conditionally that if he y^e said Daniel should not make his personal appearance before the Justices of this Court to be hold for the County and at any time During the same now sitting to Answer unto what should be objected against him on his Lordships behalf and if that in the mean time he y^e said Daniel should not be of good Behaviour And the s^r Daniel having appeared according to their Recognizance as aforesaid the said Philip Brooks & George Gleasons their Recognizances are Discharged
