John Ashley & William Ashley both of Kent County Planters at last Court as aforesaid acknowledged themselves indebted unto the Right Hon^{ble} Lord Prop^r of this Province of Maryland in the Sum of twenty pounds Sterling money of Great Brittain to be made and Levied of their Several Goods and Chattels &c for y^e use of the said Lord Prop^r of his heirs & Successors Conditionally that if the said Isaac Ashley should not make his personal appearance before the Justice of the then next Court to be hold for the County aforesaid at the Court House in the Town of Chester in the same County to answer to an Judgment found against him for felony and if that in the mean time he y^e said Isaac should not be of good Behaviour And now at this Court to wit the fifteenth Day of June Anno Domini Seventeen hundred & twenty five the said Isaac appearing their recognizances & either of them is Discharged
