

June Court 1725

The fifteenth Day of June Anno Domini Seventeen Hundred and twenty five  
The s<sup>d</sup> Bowles Appearing their Requirances and either of them <sup>in</sup> ~~by~~ <sup>Discharge</sup>

Ordered by the Court here that the s<sup>d</sup> Bowles Green Enter into recogn<sup>s</sup>  
with good Security for his appearance at next Court to Answer unto an  
Indictment found against him <sup>for felony</sup> and Good Behaviour

Thereupon Robert Green of Kent County Planter present here in Court  
in his proper person Doth Acknowledge Himself Indebted unto the Right  
Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Lord Prop<sup>r</sup> of this Province of Maryland in the Sum of twenty  
pounds Sterling money of Great Britain to be made and Leased of his  
goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements for the use of the s<sup>d</sup> Lord Prop<sup>r</sup>  
his heirs and Successors Conditionally that if he the same Bowles  
Shall not make his personal appearance before the Justices of the  
next Court to be hold for the County afo<sup>r</sup> at the Court house in the Town  
of Chester in the same County on the third Thursday of August next ensuing  
to Answer unto an Indictment found against him for felony and if that  
in the mean time he shall not be of good Behaviour where with the s<sup>d</sup>  
Bowles Doth Acknowledge himself to be Content — also —

Robert Green & Daniel Flinn both of Kent County afo<sup>r</sup> Planters  
present herein Court in their proper persons Do Acknowledge themselves  
Indebted unto the Right Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Lord Prop<sup>r</sup> of this Province of Mary<sup>l</sup>  
d<sup>e</sup> in the Sum of ten pounds Sterling money of Great Britain to be  
made & Leased of their several Goods and Chattels Lands & Tenements  
for the use of the s<sup>d</sup> Lord Prop<sup>r</sup> his heirs & Successors Conditionally that if  
the s<sup>d</sup> Bowles Green Shall not make his personal appearance before  
the Justices of the next Court to be hold for the County afo<sup>r</sup> at the Court  
house in the Town of Chester in the same County on the third Thursday  
of August next <sup>ensuing</sup> to Answer unto an Indict<sup>ment</sup> found against him for felony  
and if that in the mean time he the same Bowles Shall not be of good  
Behaviour where with the same Robert Green & Daniel Flinn are
