Robert Green & Daniel Flinn both of Kent County Planters at last Court as aforesaid Acknowledged themselves Indebted unto the Right Hon. the Lord Prop^{ty} of this Province of Maryland in the Sum of ten pounds Sterling money of Great Britain to be made and Levied of their s^d. goods and Chattels Lands & Tenements for the use of y^e. s^d. Lord Prop^{ty} his heirs & Successors Conditionally that if y^e. aforesaid Robert Green should not make his personal appearance before the Justices of the then next Court to be held for the County aforesaid at the Court house in the Town of Chester in y^e. same County to answer unto an Judgment found against him for Solony and if that in the mean time he should not be of good behaviour and
