**PRINTER:** William Peasley (?), London. Combination headpieces similar to those found on A<sub>2</sub><sup>r</sup> (p. 1) and B<sub>3</sub><sup>r</sup> (p. 11), leaf ornament similar to that found on A<sub>1</sub><sup>r</sup> (title page) and B<sub>3</sub><sup>v</sup> (p. 12) and initial letters similar to those found on A<sub>2</sub><sup>r</sup> (p. 1) and B<sub>3</sub><sup>r</sup> (p. 11) are present in this pamphlet's successor publication *A Relation of Maryland; Together, With A Map of the Countrey, . . .* (London, 1635), printed and published by William Peasley, as the title page states, "on the back-side of Drury-Lane, neere the Cockpit Playhouse."

**PAPER:** White laid; unidentified watermark in middle of spine fold on A<sub>1</sub>, A<sub>4</sub>, B<sub>1</sub>, B<sub>4</sub>.

**BINDING:** "Hayday" craft binding of full brown calf tooled and stamped in gilt: GAUDEO | [crest] | JCB. This copy has undergone repair of leaf B<sub>4</sub>.

**PROVENANCE:** Bookplate: John Carter Brown. Purchased by John Carter Brown prior to 1846—not, apparently, from Henry Stevens. Catalogue card in John Carter Brown Library notes "0375, before 1846."
