 Day to year above said did bind him selfe his heirs Executors & Administrators
 to pay or Cause to be paid into y^e s^d Michael Miller or to his certain
 Attorney his Executors Adm^r or Assignes: the full & just sum of
 quantity of four hundred twenty seven pounds of good sound
 tobacco in Cash convenient in y^e County aforesaid on or before the tenth
 Day of October next: including the said thereof: as by the s^d Will
 Relation being thereunto had may more at large Apperance under
 the s^d Thomas Norris in his last Will & Testament: nor y^e s^d James in
 his Capacity since his Death y^e s^d sum of four hundred twenty
 seven to him y^e s^d Michael though oftentimes Requested hath
 not yett paid: but y^e same to pay hath Refused to y^e Damage
 of y^e s^d Michael eight hundred fifty four pounds of tobacco in
 Cash & thereupon he brings his suite pr^ovis^o per Jo^h Wood
