f^r Robert f^r sum of three hundred eighty four pounds of tobacco
as by a bill brought produced dated f^r Edward of the 16th of Dec^r
as f^r Edward may appear being ready to be payed and remeunte and
not with standing f^r Edward in his life time did not pay unto
f^r Robert aforesaid sum of three hundred eighty four pounds of tobacco
nor f^r Edward in his f^r capacity since his death hath not paid
but f^r Edward to pay hath holden to himselfe still both f^r Edward
