Joseph Wickes & Ann his wife of one side & Benjamin Randall Late of this County Sheriff stands Attached to Answer John Tison of Talbot County a Slave of Thomas Jones Late of Talbot County Deceased in a plea of Debt

And whereas John in his last Will & Testament by Robert Smith his Attorney General & Smith that is Joseph & Ann in their last Will & Testament stand due unto John in full the just sum of three hundred & fifty pounds of tobacco by order of Talbot County Court as by bill of sale thereof by Charles King of said Court with plainly appears. Notwithstanding which Benjamin in his last Will did not pay the said sum to John in his last Will & Testament nor did Joseph & Ann in theirs since his death hath not paid out the same to said John nor do they still hold the same in a Train of of him yet John seven hundred pounds of tobacco & the same he brought his suit to Benjamin into the Court & the same by the said Smith p^{er} of the Court
