After y^e Jury being called & sworn on the Holy
Evangelists to try the Issue Juris et B. fecit
The plaintiff by himself did declare to the court
and Jury of the first article in the Defend^t all
being fifteen thousand Nine hundred & sixty
pounds of tobacco was not in the acc^t when the
acc^t was signed by the plaintiff but sometime
after the D^f sum^m was put into the acc^t by
the defend^t and the D^f plaintiff saith he hath
given credit & paid three thousand pds of the D^f
tobacco in the D^f article mentioned unto one
William Rawley, who as the plaintiff declares was
jointly concerned wth the D^f defend^t in fifteen thousand
pounds of the D^f tobacco in the D^f article so y^t he is
not obliged to pay the D^f tobacco againe to the D^f
but saith he is ready & willing to allow the remaining
part of the D^f article to be discounted wth the rest
of the D^f acc^t out of the plaintiff account
before mentioned

The Defend^t by himself saith y^t the whole sum^m
in the D^f article is properly the D^f right and not
any pt thereof doth belong to the D^f Rawley as
the plaintiff doth declare

After severall other pleadings by the plaintiff & Defend^t
The Jury having received their charge got from
the Court and after some time returned and being
called to deliver their verdict for say

W^{ch} of the Jury find for the plaintiff three
thousand five hundred & three pounds of tobacco
being the ballance of the plaintiff acc^t due from
the Defend^t & cost of sue & fe. was say all -
