 aforesaid for us & in our name to do execute & perform
 as fully largely & amply in every respect to all intents
 and purposes as we our selves might or could do if
 we were personally present ratifying allowing & holding
 firm & stable all & whatsoever our said Attorney shall
 lawfully do or cause to be done in or about the
 execution of the same by virtue of these presents
