This indenture made the 14th of June in

and In the presence of the party Inhabitants in Kent County
and In the aforesaid Province of Maryland Witnesseth
that John Parsons with the consent of his Wife
Damers. Parsons for and In consideration of the
Thousand Six hundred pounds of Tobacco to him
In hand already be paid the said Richard Dawson
heretofore to the said Richard Dawson the receipt
whereof he doth hereby acknowledge and for every
part thereof doth hereby absolutely & forever
acquitt & discharge of said Richard Dawson his
heir & Executors Administrators Assignes and by
his said Sons hath given granted bargained alienated
sold & conveyed and confirmed unto the said Richard
Dawson his heirs Assignes for ever part of a
parcel of Land called Charles his Lott lying
in Kent County on the North side of the River
beginning at a marked Buckeye Tree standing
in the County North Line it being the Eastern
boundary of the aforesaid Damers Land and
