absolutely Exonerate Acquitt & Discharge him wth Nathaniel
Euotts him his heirs exorsutors Administrators and assigns
for ever: By these presents hath given granted bargained
Alianated soule Enfeoffed and Confirmed: & by these
Doth give grant bargained Alien sell Enfeoffed & Confirmed
y^e Nathaniel Euotts his heirs or Assignes for ever
