husband of the said Judice Houffloy, and by force and virtue
of the same last will and Testament for and in Consideration
of the sum of Seven thousand and five hundred pounds of
sterling of good Gobars and Ash: to him in hand said by the
said Daniel Goode before them: a linc and delivery hereof
the receipt whereof the the said Judice Houffloy doth here by
acknowledge and hereof acquit and discharge the said Daniel Goode
his Ex: Adm: & Offic:rs, hath given granted bargained
aliened released, infeoffed and confirmed, and by these p:es
doth give grant bargain sell alien release infeoff and
confirm unto the said Daniel Goode all that tract or por-
tion of land being in Kent County and on the North side of
the Ches River and on the East side of a Creek called Goose
harow w^{ch} said tract of land is known and commonly called
by the name of Gooseharow - Beginning at a marked
poplar tree standing at the West end of a parcel of land
taken up for Doctor Darsupont and running from the said
tree for length in the Woods North East four hundred
perches, then w^{ch} a line Drawn North West two hundred
perches and fifty perches till it intersect a parcel of land
taken up by John Bowler and from thence with a line
drawn South West bounding with the said Bowler's land till
it meet w^{ch} the Ches River, and from thence bounding
with the River to the aforesaid poplar containing and
said out for five hundred acres, and with the said poplar
and appertinances whatsover to the said land belonging
or in any wise appertaining, And all the Estate right title
interest claim and demand whatsover to the said land
belonging or appertaining w^{ch} provision p: Remains-
Remainder and Remainders of all and singular the said
bargain: & promise, deeds, patents, deeds and writings
touching the said bargain: & promise, do have and hold
the same unto the said Daniel Goode with all and
