of Chester ^{County} of Kent Gentles being sworn on
the 29th of June 1679

And the Deponents saith as followeth: That a Bay ward age
about ten years That was lately in the possession of Vincent Robinson
son of the now deceased of the said Robinson was given unto
Mary Robinson Daughter of the said Vincent Robinson
by her father Vincent Robinson in Exchange of a Black
Mare that was formerly in the possession of the said Vincent
Robinson: And the said Vincent Robinson is deceased: And several
times and the said Bay ward to the said Vincent Robinson
in his oath further saith that the said Vincent Robinson did
several times say that the said female in the possession of the said Bay ward
he would give unto his Daughter Mary is further saith the
