

This Indenture made by 16th day of may in year of our dominion of 1571
 Moste Honorable Charles Lord and Proprietarie of the Province of Maryland and
 Baron Lord Barron of Baltimore and 1st yeare of our Lord one thousand
 six hundred Eighty and seauen Between Charles Whitehead and Sarah
 his wife of the County of Kent. Trunkell of the one partie and William
 Foreman of the same County Planter of the other partie witnesseth that he late
 Charles Whitehead and Sarah his wife for and in consideration of the sum of
 Thirteen thousand pounds of good tobacco to him or them in hand at and
 before the en-saling and delivery of this presente by the said William Foreman
 well and truly paid the receipt whereof by said Charles Whitehead and Sarah
 his wife do hereby acknowledge them selfes fully satisfied and paid and thereto
 and to every part and parcel thereof to the said William Foreman
 the said William Foreman his heires Executors for ever by these presents
 hath given granted aliened Bargained sold Entertayned and confirmed
 unto the saids debtors full liberty and absolutely quiet grant in your will
 Enteres and exentes unto the said William Foreman his heires Executors and Rightes
 to all that parcel or tract of Land called the maner of Coddington in the
 County of Kent near the stadt of Rochester called Swithenby begynning at all
 I mirede Chesnutt tree being A bounder tree of the middle coniers therin
 falle and running downe into said Creek for breake water to the next hundred
 roodtree to a small brod Oak bounded on y^e north side of S Creek Coddington
 Creek from a lode oak for Length by a line drawn from west to
 hundred roods in parishes to y^e land called Coddington and thereto adioyneth
 to it in effect with y^e Land of Charles Whitehead & Sarah his wife in maner
 to y^e first bounder tree containinge now laid out to two hundred roods
 more or lesse together with all profits benefits & rightes thereunto belonginge et in
 any wise apartairing all y^e said Land w^t its wchis members & appartenances
 whatsoevre now inde by these presents mentioned or contained in these grants
 and by this lyinge being in Kent without other aid and now in your sellion
 Charles Whitehead & Sarah his wife y^e reutte 1571 by these presents
 all singular & every mentoned premises & all grants thereto made of the
 same by any partie gettall thereof and all y^e righte & title Entayned thereto
 per it selfe property & demand whiche ever y^e have by said Charles
 Whitehead and Sarah his wife in or to y^e same in any partie gettall thereto
 to haue and hold y^e said land & ali singular other y^e premises by q^uarre
 bargained & by every of them rights members and appartenances
 what so ever unto y^e said William Foreman his heires & assigees
 proper unto y^e bodye of him y^e said William Foreman his heires & assigees
 & quod And the said Charles Whitehead & Sarah his wife for themselves
 their heires Executors and Administrators doe hereby Covenant promise
 grant & agree to and w^t y^e said William Foreman his heires and assigees
 and Every of them by these presents in maner and forme following that is
 to say that he y^e said Charles Whitehead & Sarah his wife all y^e sealing &
 delivery of these presents haue in them selues full power geal right and
 Lawfull authoritie to grant bargaine & sell all and singular the before
 toobly granted premises w^t their appertenances unto y^e said William
 Foreman his heires & assigees in maner and forme aforesaid that he y^e
 said William Foreman his heires and assigees shall and may by testi
 monies from time to time and at all times for ever neare or farre
 haue use & occupie posse and enioy y^e said land and all and singular thereto
 before granted premises and haue Recouerance and take the rents & dues and
