and shall from time to time hereafter well &  
truly observe performe fulfill & keep all & singular  
y<sup>e</sup> covenants grants conditions & covenants in or y<sup>e</sup>  
part of y<sup>e</sup> to Benjamin Blacklock his heirs Executors  
Admins and ought to be observed performed & kept  
contained specified & declared in one pair of indentures  
of grant bargain & sale bearing date with this  
obligation made betwixt y<sup>e</sup> Benjamin Black-  
lock of y<sup>e</sup> one part and y<sup>e</sup> above named Thomas  
Joss of the other part & that in & by all things written  
& specified in y<sup>e</sup> said indentures that then the above  
obligation to be void else to remaine in full force &
