} demands one servant boy which Thomas Howard  
} in his life time had from Nicholas Clouds & y<sup>e</sup> p<sup>l</sup>t  
} Griffith Jones to be accountable unto y<sup>e</sup> p<sup>l</sup>t Clouds for  
} his last years crop of Corn & tob<sup>o</sup> this being all that  
} is agreed upon by us & y<sup>e</sup> true report we make in  
} obedience of the Commission to us directed Given under  
} our hands this 25 of 7<sup>th</sup> mo<sup>r</sup> 1688

The Court having heard y<sup>e</sup> above report doo give judgment  
that y<sup>e</sup> p<sup>l</sup>t Nicholas Clouds shall recover from y<sup>e</sup> p<sup>l</sup>t y<sup>e</sup> sum  
of four hundred sixty & one pounds of tob<sup>o</sup> as also one servant  
boy & likewise to be accountable for y<sup>e</sup> p<sup>l</sup>t servants crop for y<sup>e</sup>  
year last past. vera copia taken from y<sup>e</sup> record

March y<sup>e</sup> 29: 1689 By virtue of a warrant of attorney from M<sup>r</sup>  
Nicholas Clouds of Talbot County I doo hereby discharge y<sup>e</sup> within Griffith  
Jones & upon Exec<sup>r</sup> of Thomas Howard from y<sup>e</sup> within judgment to y<sup>e</sup>  
p<sup>l</sup>t Clouds having received full satisfaction to y<sup>e</sup> p<sup>l</sup>t judgment

More y<sup>e</sup> said Clouds acknowledges satisfaction  
for y<sup>e</sup> crop of y<sup>e</sup> within servant being five hundred  
& sixty pounds of tob<sup>o</sup> Elias King

These two acknowledgments on y<sup>e</sup> back of  
the above judgment
