of March in y^e year of our Lord (1692) & in y^e 4th
year of their most^{ties} Reign and betwene John
Jones of Kent or Talbot County in y^e provinces of
Maryland Brazier of y^e one part & Francis Stevens
of Kent County planter of y^e other p^t. Witnesses
that y^e s^d John Jones for & in consideration of y^e
sum of or quantity of five thousand pounds of s^t
already paid & to be paid by y^e s^d Francis Stevens
& for divers good causes & other considerations him y^e
^{John Jones} sheweth moving too by those presents & signing
& sealing y^e same hath given granted bargained sold
Alienac^{ed} enfranchis^{ed} & confirmed & by these presents
doth fully freely & absolutely give grant bargain
sell alien^{ac} enfranchis^{ed} & confirms unto y^e s^d Francis
Stevens his heirs & assigns for ever all y^e parcel
of Land called Joneses plot ~~then~~ lying & being on
Kent Island in Kent County beginning at a marked
Spanish oak standing at y^e head of great thicket
brooke & on y^e north east side of y^e s^d Island &
running South two hundred & twenty perches then
South East eighty perches then South & by East forty
& eight perches to a marked black oak being a bound
ed tree of W^m Joyner standing at y^e head of Long
brooke standing on y^e west side of y^e s^d brooke then
west to a marked pine tree standing on y^e East side
of y^e Eastern brooke then north & by East up y^e s^d brook
eighty four perches to a small marked pine standing
at y^e head of y^e s^d brooke then north west & by west
forty two perches to a marked Red oak then North
one hundred & twenty perches to a marked white
oak & from thence to y^e first boundd tree ~ ~
