running East leaving six pchs East south East
twenty four pchs by a line drawn from y^e end
of y^e East south East line & running north North
East one hundred & sixty pchs unto the first
boundes white oak containing & now laid out
for one hundred acres more or less to be holden
of the manor of Balsomoro (called Piny point

day of Aprill Anno (1667) together with all y^e
