This Indenture this nineteenth day of November
Anno quo domo one thousand six hundred ninety one
and in the seventh year of the reign of our sovereign lord
and lady William & Mary by the grace of God of
England Scotland France & Ireland King & Queen & first
of the said W. & M. George Green of first family
proprietor of Maryland planter of the one part and
Benjamin Blackbath of the family & province aforesaid
of the other part written with that the said George Green
for and in consideration of the sum or quantity of the two
thousand pounds of tobacco in hand paid at or before
the Enrolling & delivery of these presents by the said Benja-
min Blackbath of the one part & the said Geo. Green
the said George Green doth hereby acquit discharge
the said Benjamin Blackbath his heirs executor admors
& assigns by these presents doth fully clearly & absolutely give
grant bargain sell alien Enkoff & confirm unto the said
Benjamin Blackbath his heirs or assigns a parcel of
land containing one hundred acres being part of a tract
of land called Pentridge and the one moiety of the two
hundred acres of the said tract called Pentridge and the
said George Green bought of Thomas Thorpe & Elizabeth his
wife as by the bearing date of the said day of November
Anno 1688 & recorded in books & records may fully appear
the said parcel or part of land beginning at a marked oak
standing near of first called Langford's bag first and running
from the said oak for breadth forty perches unto another
marked oak & from the said oak running north & st. into the
woods for one hundred perches & from the end of the last st.
