of Kent County. I passed and one bay mare
one father to be bought two pillows one
one blanket and one pair of best white
clothes. Moreover two hundred pounds of tobacco
to my said friend John Wheeler as aforesaid to
have and to hold for ever all which negro and
other things being all ready to be sold. I do give
John Wheeler as aforesaid to be of value and signing
of these presents which said negro and other things
aforesaid I do give & bequeath as aforesaid from
me my being Executor admr or assignee for ever
as witness my hand & seal this 30th day
of July 1694.
