 severally to keep the peace in said County & to keep yours to be kept
 all laws & Ordens for the good government of the peace & for quiet
 Rule & Government of the people in all & every the districts of the same
 & to chastise & punish all persons offending against the form of any law
 made & Ordained by this Our Province or any of them in said County aforesaid
 as according to the form of these Laws the said shall suffice to be done. We have
 also constituted & ordained you & every person or more of you of which you
 the said William Griffy Edward Harrison John Winson & Thomas Smith & John
 Coggage or one of you are alvaged to be one of the same to be enquired by 3
 good & lawfull men of yo^r County aforesaid of all and all manner of malice & malice
 & wronge & uncharitableness & other evill & uncharitableness & other evill
 & extortions whatsoever & of all & singular other malice & offenses & Offenses & wronges
 matters relating to tithes of land of which Justice of the peace in England & Ireland
 or ought lawfully to enquire by whosoever or whom so ever done or perpetrated
 or which hereafter shall happen to be done or perpetrated in this County & their against
 & Laws & Ordens of this Our Province provided that you & others not in any of the
 cases aforesaid to take life or member but that in every such case you send the
 persons with their Injuries & the persons matter aforesaid before you to the next
 Court to be holden for this Our Province whereupon you will be directed to be holden there to
 be tryed. And further we do hereby authorize & empower you to send the persons
 aforesaid to hold assizes of eyre & Common Pleas in all actions not exceeding & fees of
 Execution and pounds of debts & after Judgement given toward in all cases
 Civil whether small or great according to the laws Ordens & reasonable fees
 made & provided in this Our Province of Maryland in which cause first for to
 be tryed & reported as the first & proper of we do constitute & ordain to appoint you
 severally & respectively of each as aforesaid to be judges as aforesaid of the persons aforesaid
 command you that you diligently attend the holding of the peace laws & Ordens &
 singular other of persons at certain days appointed according to day of return
 in such cases made & provided at such place where you or any officer of you aforesaid
 aforesaid shall in that behalf & appoint you make enquiry upon the aforesaid persons
 & fulfill & serve in forme aforesaid to do the persons that will to the best of your
 abilities according to the laws Ordens & reasonable fees of this our County &
 to us the Inhabitants & others living both abiding & sojourning therin for we
 command the Sheriff of o^r County of Kent by virtue of his office & power
 & day & at the place aforesaid that you or any such officer or officers of you
 aforesaid shall also know & to him to give his attencion on you & his
