 their parts Well & truly well observe performe fulfill & keep all
 & singular the said Grants Licenses & Assignments which on
 y^e part to be had of y^e said Lacy and to be taken & enjoyed
 performed fulfill'd Done as he is bound as specified in the
 part of Indentures bearing Date y^e 25th Day of this Instant June
 made between y^e said William Lacy of the one part & the said
 John Bontas of the other part: According to y^e true Intent and
 meaning thereof: That this obligation to be void & of none effect
 or else to stand remaine & Abide in full power force & strength to
 y^e said
