 did at the said Southwark to wit the 10th day of November
 last in the County of Surrey by and with John M^r. George
 his plantation in the said County of Surrey the sum of
 £100 not lawfully due and owing to a person unknown to the value
 of three hundred pounds of Robarts the Town and three hundred
 pounds being away returned to their said Town and found in
 such case made their oaths signed by M^r. Matthew Smith

 doth put himself upon God and the country which is all
