 for and during the term of One whole Year ending from
 the date of these presents hereby willing and requiring You to
 well receive and take into your custody all Records
 Deeds writs writs papers and Enrolments what so ever unto
 the said Countie belonging or in anywise appertaining and
 the same to preserve and preserve to the best of Your power and
 to doe hereby Authorize and empower You to act and
 performe the Office of Clerk and Keeper of the Records of the
 said Countie, as fully and amply as any Clerk of a Countie Court
 in this Province may or ought to doe causing and receiving
 to you selfe the full tenth part of all and singular the
 fees profits and benefitts of weight to the said place and office
 appertaining or in anywise appertaining and the
 other nine parts to take have hold and enjoy to your own
 use and behoofe so long as You shall continue in the
 said Office Given at St. Marys the 29th day of October under
 our hand and Seale Anno Domini 1694
