Sarah Smith and Elizabeth Boob being returned by the grand Jurors which presentment being read the Clerk of the Indictment desiring it may be continued until next Court in Charles Field on one of the May^r:s Evidence being incapable of attending the Court which accordingly is ordered Simon Wimer Clerk

Court adjourns till 4th Morrow 8 of the Clock
