

To be riotously Disorderly when there att the supposition
 of the fact committed word known both in the said persons
 and Number for which Uncertainty the Regent before ought
 to be Arrested the reasons whereof may appear, by the Statute
 primo Maria Cap: 12: enacted severall years for punishing Riot
 proportionall to the Number & stonnes and Nature of the fact intended
 for the want of which no certaine Indictment can be given therfore
 ought to be Arrested as aforesaid that the said Indictment
 is affod that such may appear by word or prouidence together
 with word of sequent viz with several others Riotously
 affonied &c: whereas no person att intend to make
 good the Matter contained in the Indictment did make appear
 that any persons word concerned in the said Assault said Ann
 Queen Marye that by his confession of the party supposed to be
 injured unto Mary Shandor Queene of the bordour as may appear
 by her Oath therfore the said Ann could not be charged w
 a Riot for which facit in the said Indictment contained
 Indictment ought to be Arrested as aforesaid

Forsooth therefore Riot must consist of about 400 persons in Number
 and Under whiche persons must appear as appear by
 Maria Cap: 12: and more with one intent to disturb the peace
 otherwise it cannot be a Riot for if three or more more
 and one of the three garn a house make an affay to commit
 a trespass or forcably dray another man threft the selfe
 present making no shew of aiding or assistance therin such
 persons soone by present cannot be said Rioters and for rea-
 son that the party offending not liable to be indicted of a Riot
 but the party aggred may otherwise bring his present to
 action for the injury or damage at the Law in such case the
 divers but that they haue otherwise proceeded in the present
 as aforesaid and Indicted the said Ann for Riotousness being an
 assault wheras no evidence made it appear nor did any person
 any other then said matter of fact alwaist the said Ann
 Indictment ought to be Arrested
