Kent B. Cornelius Comey of the County aforesaid Gent Francis Atterbed to Answer unto Edward Bathurst in a plea of Respasp upon the Cap<sup>t</sup> Bond  
Wherupon the said Edward by Counsel his Attorney com<sup>pl</sup>ainth and saith that the said Cornelius for his own good Honor and Maintenance is him selfe and delivered as he petitioned amongst in Court proce<sup>du</sup>re bearing date the 30<sup>th</sup> day of March Anno 1694 may appoynt stand fully & modestly to him in the full and just sum of One thousand One hundred Sixty and One p<sup>er</sup>cent of Tobacco in consideration & reward of the said Comey's bid faithfully promise and upon himselfe did Assure the aforesaid sum to pay said Satis for which he should be thownto required Nevertheless the said Cornelius his said promise and Assumption not regarding the aforesaid sum of 1141 60<sup>s</sup>: all the other thownto required hath not paid but the said Edward saith he is damnified 2282 60<sup>s</sup>: Wherupon he bringeth this Suit
