Know all Men that Thomas Collins of Kent County Gent: stands Attached to answer to Benjamin Dollon Merchant of a plea of trespass upon the case And whereupon the said Bons: by William Homfroy his Attorney complains that whereas the said Thomas the 20th day of March Anno Domini 1694 in sd County within the Jurisdiction of this Court stood justly indebted to the said Bons: the full and just sum of two hundred and fifty pounds of Tobacco by Obligation of Assumpsit the particulars thereof are here in Court books in recollection thereof the said Thomas upon himselfe Assumed and to the sd Bons: faithfully promised that he the sd Thomas the sd sum of two hundred and fifty pounds of Tobacco unto the sd Bons: would well and truly pay when thereunto required. Yett Never the less the sd Thomas the sd sum of 250^l Tobacco according to his promise and Assumption aforesd to the sd Bons: he hath not paid altho he the sd Thomas by him the sd Bons: on the 10th day of June Anno Domini 1696 att Christ Church River in sd County within the Jurisdiction of this Court to doo the same hath therunto been required but the said to pay hath denied and refused to the damages of the sd Bons: five hundred pounds of Tobacco and thereupon he bringt this suit
