

I do bind himself his Heirs Executors Administrators or Assignes to pay
 or cause to be paid unto the sd Phillimon his Heirs Executors Administrators
 the sd sum of 1620 of Tobacco qualified as aforesaid 1000
 yearly in sd County att or upon the tenth day of October the
 next ensuing the date of the said Bill yet notwithstanding
 the sd William in his life time the said sum of 1620 of Tobacco
 qualified according to the tenor of the said Bill unto the sd
 Phillimon they did not pay nor the said Sarah when sold
 and notwithstanding Stephen and Sarah lived their intermarriage
 nor either of them in any of their respective lives the death
 death of the sd Wm they have not paid altho often demanded
 but the said to pay they have denied and refused to the
 damage of the sd Phillimon the sum of three thousand
 pounds of Tobacco and thereupon he brings this suit
 Hambley vs Phillimon

To which the sd Stephen Whitford appearing but making
 no answer doth defend urgent is awarded for the said sum
 of 1500 pounds of Tobacco

Therefore it is considered by this Court that the sd Phillimon
 Hambley doth recover from the doct Stephen Whitford
 and Sarah his exors of William Drane and out of the
 estate of the sd William Drane the sd sum of sixteen hundred
 pounds of Tobacco as affore of suit
