Command was given to the Sheriff of Kent County to take the Body of Charles Hollingsworth Jun: if he should be found in his Bailiwick so that he have his Body before his Mas^{ty} Justice at the next Court to be held for said County to Answer unto Nathaniel Wright of a plea that he render unto him 4800 of Tobacco to
Witnesse William Frisby Gent &c: the 20th Day of August Anno Dom 1696

At which said Court viz: the 27th Day of October Anno Dom 1696 being adjourned from the 22th Day of September 1696 the Day of the return of the said writt came Capt: Edward Swatman High Sheriff of said County and returned the said writt in these following Words viz: Copi Corpus of Edw: Swatman Sheriff

which said action as above being called the said Defend^t: Byssam: Withers his Attorney appeared and impared until next Court the same day is given to the Pet likewise which being still returne wood from Court to Court to this present day but the said Def^t neither by himselfe nor by his Attorney making any defence by the same, Judgment is awarded by Default

Therefore it is considered by this Court that the Pet Nathaniel Wright doe recover from the Defend^t Charles Hollingsworth Jun: as he hath a forsaide summe of four thousand Eight hundred pound of Tobacco as alsoe the summe of five hundred and ffire pound of Tobacco cost of suit
