 by his certain bill or writ in law obligatory sealed with his seal a this
 Act and deed delivered and first into Court brought whose date
 is the said day and Year did bind himself his Heirs Executors
 Adm^r to pay or cause to be paid unto the said Petitioner his Heirs
 Ex^r Adm^r or Assigns the said sum of 1645 of Tobacco reasonable
 in said County upon demand yett notwithstanding the said William
 the said sum of 1645 of Tobacco according to the tenor of the
 said bill unto the said Petitioner he hath not paid altho he hath so
 William Down hath therunto been often demanded but the said
 to pay he hath denied and refused to the demand of the said Petitioner
 one three thousand pounds of Tobacco and thereupon bringing
 this suit

 prays judgment of 804 of Tob: by him paid in part of the above
 mentioned bill which being by this Court and Pet^r allowed of
 is awarded for the Pet^r being 845 of Tobacco

 Homfroy doo recover from the Def^d: William Downes with the
 said sum of Eight hundred forty and One pound of Tobacco
 as also the sum of two hundred forty and seven pounds of
 Tobacco cost of suit
