And whereupon the said Henry by Wm Henry Esq: his Attorney
saith that whereas the said John Huos on the 20th day of July
Anno Dom 1693 in the sd County within the Jurisdiction of this
Court by his certain bill or writtine obligatory sealed with his
seal as his Act and good colour ed and hold in Court brought
where date is the said day and word did bind him selfe his Heires
Exors Assigns to pay or cause to be paid unto the said
Henry Coffin his Heires Exors Assigns the said sum
of 400 Tobacco qualified as aforesaid convenient in Chesser
River attorn upon the 16th day of October then Next ensuing
pass of the same bill yett withstanding the said John Huos the
said sum of 400 of Tobacco according to the ten: of the said
bill unto the said Henry Coffin he hath not paid all the of said sum
nor but the same to pay he hath done and refused and still doth
to the damage of the said Henry 200 of Tob: & thereupon he bringeth this
suit
