And now at this day came in both the said William Hrisby
 by Wm: Hemsey his Attorney as all the said John Lee
 by Griffith Jones his Attorney and the matter standing for
 trial the said Griffith Jones pleads non sum in forma

Therefore it is considered by this Court that the Pet:
 William Hrisby doe recover from the Defend: John Lee
 as well the aforesaid sum of Eight hundred pounds
 and One pound of Tobacco as all the sum of Two
 hundred Sixty and Three pounds of Tobacco cost of suit
