

of this Court by his certain bill or writing obligatorie sealed with
 his seale of his Art and doo delivered and filed in Court
 brought whose date is the same day and there did bind
 himselfe his Heires Executors to pay or cause to be paid
 unto the said Thomas Shoak for his Heires Executors or
 assignes the sume of 1200 lib: qualified as aforesaid condition
 in said County or upon the fourth day of November then next
 next ensuing the date of the said bill. Yet notwithstanding
 the said John Bowles the said sume of 1200 of Tobacco and
 according to the tenor of the said bill unto the said Thomas
 Shoak for he hath not paid all the aforesaid demander but the
 same to pay he hath denied and refused to the damage
 of the said Thomas Shoak for 500 three hundred pounds of
 Tobacco and thereupon he brings this suit
 How say you? pleads he: *in: Plea: Rex*

And the said John Bowles in his proper performent and
 prayer of prayer according to Act of Assembly in heretofore
 made and provided of his certain Act here in Court
 brought amounting to the sume of eight hundred and
 fifty pounds of Tobacco which Act being proved and that
 the said goods were delivered to Thomas Parker in part satis-
 faction of the above mentioned Bill to witness the said bill
 was delivered by Thomas Shoak for proved in open Court by
 the Oath of the said John Bowles who is therefore awarded
 for the Bill: being 350 of Tob.

Therefore it is considered by this Court that the said
 Thomas Shoak do recover from the Defendant John Bowles as
 well the sume of three hundred and fifty pounds of Tobaco
 as also the sume of two hundred forty and seven pounds
 of Tobacco rest of suit.
