

And the sd Thomas stood in his proper person come and appear
to the said Accon and bring with a Copy of the order
according to Act of Asssembly in this case made and provided
But making no reasonable objection against the said Judgment
is awarded for said sum of three hundred and two pounds of
Tobacco and cost

Therefore it is considered by this Court that the p^r John Hawkins
doe recover as well the said sum of three hundred and two
pounds of Tobacco as also the sum of two hundred thirty
and nine pounds of Tobacco cost of suit

Command was given to the Sheriff of Kent County the 2^o day
of November Anno Dom 1696 to take Richard Gaye if he
should be found in his Bailiwick and him safe kept so that
he have his Body before his Mas^{ties} Justices at the next Court to
be held for sd County to answer unto John Hawkins of a plea
of Trespasse upon the case

At which Court viz this present day the day of the return of
the writ aforesaid came present Edward Sweatnam Esq^r Sheriff
of said County and made return of said writ in these words

And the sd J^r: by Samuel Withers his Attorney complained that
whereas the sd Richard the 22 day of Feb^r: Anno Dom 1694 at Dover
River within the jurisdiction of this Court by his certain Brethren sub:
scribed with his hand as his Act an. do^o delivered and here in force
brought whose date is the same day and year a former note &
promise to pay to the sd John Hawkins by order of One J^r: Saltor the
sum of two hundred twenty and four pounds of Tobacco &
in consideration thereof the sd Richard upon their behalf assumed
to the sd J^r: factually promised that he did to Richard the
aforesaid
