doe pay or owe as wch the said summe of Thirt hundred and two
pounds of Tobacco as alſo the summe of Two hundred thirty
and Nine pounds of Tobacco Cost of suit.

brayed with his hand at his backe and doone delivered and had in four
Bills of exchange whose date is the same day and year aforesaid
promised to pay to the said Mithers by orders of his selfe saltor the
summe of one hundred twenty and four pounds of Tobacco &
in consideration whereof the said Richard upon his last appearance
to this Court faithfully promised that he did to Richard the
aforesaid
