 said See that by writ of my Office I have Attached y^e said 383
 of Tobacco in the hands of him the said John Robinson and have
 summoned the said John Robinson to this Court to shew cause if any
 he have why the same should not be condemned for the use aforesaid
 and pray yo: Worshipes that the same may be condemned for the same
