Upon Representatⁿ by some of the grand Jury to this Court that
the New Road cleared from Simon Wilmer's Mill to the Court house
being cleared into Langford's Bay Road is neither the most direct way
nor y^e most convenient for the Inhabitants of the upp^r part of
this County
