and being accordingly admitted takes the Oath appointed by Act
of Parliament instead of y^e Oath of Allegiance and Supremacy

Command was Given to the Sheriff of West County y^e 30th Day of
October Anno Dom 1696 that he take Nicholas Cloudes if he should

Bill or Writing obligatory sealed with his Seale as his Act and deed obli^g
ed and here in Court brought whose date is the same Day and
