

Command was given to the Sheriff of Kent County the 28th day of Jan^y Anno Dom 1696 that by good and lawfull men of his Bailiwick he make knowne unto W^m True if he should be found in his Bailiwick so that he do and appeare before his Majesty's Justices at the next Court to show cause if hee will why Execution should not issue against him for One hundred forty and two pounds of Tobacco according to a Judgment obtained against him the 27th day of March Anno Dom 1695 by Charles Giddon

At which Court viz: the 23th day of March Anno Dom 1696 came Capt Edward Swatnam his High Sheriff of the County and made returne of the said Writ in these following words viz: I have made knowne unto the within mentioned W^m True before James Conway and Thomas Stophony that he do and appeare to show cause as by this within precept I am commanded Do: Swatnam Sheriff

And now here at this day the said W^m True Motion by him selfe nor by his attorney showing unreasonable cause why Execution should not issue according to the aforesaid Judgment:

Therefore it is considered by this Court that the Plant: Charles Giddon recover from the Defend: W^m True as well the aforesaid sum of One hundred forty and two pounds of Tobacco according to the aforesaid former Judgment as also the sum of One hundred twenty and six pounds of Tobacco of his
