

Command was given to the Sheriff of Kent County 9th Day of Jul
anno Dom 1696 that by good and Lawfull men of his Bailiwick
he make knowne to Robert Browne so that he do and appears
before his Maj^{ty} Justice atty Next Court to shew cause if he
why Execution should issue at him for four hundred pounds
of Tobacco due to Simon Wilmer for Clerk Hoop

At which Court Court viz: the 23rd Day of March Anno Dom
1696 the day of return of the sd writ beame Capt: Edward H
Sudatnam Justice Sheriff of sd County and made returne of sd
writ in these words following viz: I have made knowne to
the within named Rob^t Browne before Edward Ruff and H
Capt: Ruff that he do and appears &c. as by this procept I am H
commanded Edw: Sudatnam Sheriff

And now here att this day the sd Robert Browne applying but
bringing no reasonable cause to shew why Execution should not
issue

Therefore it is considered by this Court that the pet Simon Wilmer
have Execution at the defendt: Robert Browne as well for the
aforsd sum of four hundred pounds of Tobacco debt as also for
the sum of two hundred Quarts and six pounds of Tobacco
cost of suit
