why he should not paye him for ffourteen hundred thirty
and eight poundes of Tobacco a certain Debt and cost Recovered
him by Michael Miller att a Court holden the 26th day of June Anno
Dom 1695 for sd County

of returne of the sd writt came first Edward Swetnam Sheriff
of sd County and made Returne of sd writt in these words viz: I
have made knowne to the within named Jⁿ: Rafe before Thomas Smith
and Richard Greig that he do and appears before the Court as by this present
I am commanded Edw: Swetnam Mst

And Now here at this day comes the sd John Rafe with James Conway his former
who promises that the sd Jⁿ: Rafe shall paye to the sd Michael Miller the
sume of ffourteen hundred thirty and eight poundes of Tobacco with cost of suit
as well as in 30th June
