Known all men by these presents That I William Thomas of Kent County in y^e
 Province of Maryland Gentleman heth by firmly bound unto Damd Kelly
 and William Shedd both of them y^e afores^d County the summe & plantis
 The full just sume or quantity of eighteen thousand pounds of good sound
 well Confectioned Merchantable tobacco to be paid to y^e 2^d Jan^ury
 Kelly & William Shedd to them or either of them their heirs executors
 administrators or assigns to the which payment to be truly made & payed
 I the bim^e me my heire executors administrators or assigns firmly by
 these presents sealed w^m handes sealed w^m seal set thereto the 24th day of July
 in the fourth year of the Dominion of Charles King of England

The Condition of this obligation is such that whereas the aboue bound
 William Thomas by his Testamente bearing Date w^m these presents
 for the Consideration theron expressed thus bargained and said
 unto aboue named Damd Kelly & William Shedd their heirs to
 y^e 2^d Jan^ury next coming to have & to hold to them thos Damd
 Kelly & William Shedd their heirs and assigns for ever w^m warrant
 against all persons what so ever as by the said Testame doth most at
 large appear to therfore y^e 2^d William Thomas his heirs executors
