came Capt Edward Sweetman Sheriff of the County &
made Returne of said Plaintiff in these following Wordz etc:

And the said Daniel Morris on the said 23rd Day of March &
applying by William Hemmings his Attorney prayes therof to Im-
panel which was granted and the same Day was given to the
Defendt

And now heretofore Day vis: the 23rd Day of June and
the said Daniel Morris by William Hemmings his Attorney
the said Pet: not profferring his Acc^{nt} Judgment is awarded for a
Non suit

Therefore it is considered by this Court that the Defendt:
Daniel Morris doth recover from the Pet: William Hemmings with
the summe of fiftys poundes of Gobanno for a Non suit or else
the summe of One hundred and fiftys poundes of Gobanno cost
of suit.
