 aforesaid to take life or Member but that in Every Justice You  
 send the Prisoners with their judgments and the whole matter de-  
 pending before You to the next Provincial Court to be held for the  
 this our Province in her favor or where ever to be held there to  
 be tried and passed upon hereby Authoris'd and impow'r you  
 to issue out writs Proces and Assessments and to hold Plea of  
 over and forswear in all Actions real personal and mixed and  
 after Judgment Execution to Award in such publick according to  
 the Lawes orders and reasonable Customs made and provided in  
 this our Province of Maryland Except matters relating to Lands of  
 Land in which may Civil suit to be tried Excepting as before excepted  
 you do constitute and appoint you the several and respective Towns  
 as aforesaid to be Judges as aforesaid And therefore hood doth command you  
 You diligently attend the Recency of the Lawes and Orders of  
 all and singular other the places and at certaine Tyme appointed  
 according to Act of Assembly in such manner and provide and  
 att such place as you or any four or more of you or aforesaid shall see  
 that so farre as you make Inquiry upon the places and  
 performed and fulfill the same in forme aforesaid Doining therin  
 what to Justice appertaineth according to the Lawes Orders and  
 reasonable Customs of this our Province And therefore hood doth  
 command the Sheriff of our County by virtue of those powers  
 that att his place and on his day appointed that you or any sufficient  
 or more of you as aforesaid shall make you to him that he may  
 his Attendance on you And if need require him to come before  
 you or any such four or more of you such and so many good &  
 Lawfull men of your County by whom the truth of the premises  
 may the better be knowne and required And supply you therewith  
 to be brought before you on the day and at the place aforesaid  
 Proces and Judicature to your Court and Jurisdiction before going  
 that they have may be supported and defend cause determined  
 Rightly Our Trusty and well beloved friend the Governor  
 on Capt: Gen: and Procuror in Chief in and over our Province  
 and Territories of Maryland this sixteenth Day of June in the  
 Ninth Year of our Raigne Anno Domini 1647
