 at Chester River in West County within the Jurisdiction of this
 Court he was therunto required by the said John Hawkins but
 the same to pay he the said John Hues doth deny to the damage
 of the said John Hawkins five hundred pounds of Tobacco
 and thereupon he bring this suit

 it appear that he had paid of the said Debt Eight pounds of
 Tobacco being overpaid in the foregoing Answer Judgment is

 doe Recover from the Defend: John Hues as well the aforesaid
 sum of two hundred thirty and four pounds of Tobacco
 as also the sum of three hundred sixty and seven pounds
 of Tobacco cost of suit
