Sarah Daniel and John Boas of a plea of trespass upon the Capt And whereupon the sd Sarah Daniel and John by W<sup>m</sup> Homfroy their Attorney complaineth that whereas the sd Hugh Marsh on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of October Anno Dom 1696 at the River River within the Jurisdiction of this Court stood Justly indebted unto them the said Sarah Daniel and John the full and just sum of seven thousand pounds of Tobacco in the value thereof in Indian Comod & which to wit: whereas at fifty pounds of Tobacco ff Buffalo in Indian Comod a it twenty pounds of Tobacco ff Buffalo it being the several paymt: to be made by him the sd Hugh unto them the said Sarah Daniel and John for a certain Water Mill with the appurtenances
