And Thompson his said Eliz: in her capacity by Thomas Courfey her
atty saith that whereas the said Daniel on the 16th day of March anno
1686 in pd County within the Jurisdiction of this Court by his certain
Bill or Bill of Exchange sealed with his Seal as his Act and doth
decreed and had in Court brought whose date is the same day
and year did acknowledge himself to owe and stand still in arrears
indebted unto the said Thomas in his life time the sum of 1220
of tobacco qualified as aforesaid to be paid remonably in two or
three or upon the 10th day of October next ensuing for the
same and faithfully payed whereof he the said Daniel did bind him
before his Heires Exec: and Adm: firsly by the said Bill
notwithstanding the said Daniel the sum of 1220 of tobacco and
according to the sum of the same gift unto the said Thomas in his life time
he did not pay nor to the said Eliz: in her capacity since the death
of him the said tho: he hath not paid but he saith to pay he hath
denied and refused and first off done and refused to the damages of
the said Eliz: that the sum of 2440 of tobacco and thereupon
