 the full and just sum of four hundred seventy and four poundes
 of Tobacco &c

At which Court viz the 22th day of June Anno Dom 1697 the day of
 Return of a writt came Capt: Edward Brocton High Sheriff of the
 County and made Return of said writt in these words viz Capt
 Jm. Elms: Invenitiam thost

On which day came the said Thomas Collins by Michael Earle his
 Attorney and prayer therof to Imparce untill the next Court which
 was granted the same time is given to the Pet likewise

And now hold at this day viz the 25th day of August Anno Dom
 1697 came as well the said Pet by Richard Markley their atty
 and also for the said Defend: by Michael Earle his Attorney and
 the said Accon standing for Jural
